Kick on the entire width of the pool using sculling hands. Flutter kick on stomach and back in streamline. Flutter kick on side.

Prepare for Swim Classes

Hydration: You sweat in the pool – exercising causes loss of water. Bring a water bottle, a small amount of Gatorade is useful in a full bottle as well.

Band-Aids: Do not stay on, in the water; waterproof or not, they will come off. Please take them off and any open wound should be kept away from the swimming pool. Don't let a bandaid come off in the pool and others swim through it.

Please bring a cap and goggles, (As they are required to get into the pool)
